

Sewer District Welcomes North Shore Hebrew Academy *Great Neck Water Pollution Control District Offers Tour of Environmentally Friendly Plant for Local High School Students*

The Great Neck Water Pollution Control District (GNWPCD) recently invited North Shore Hebrew Academy students to the District's East Shore Road facility, one of the most environmentally conscious wastewater treatment plants in the Northeast.

GNWPCD Superintendent Christopher Murphy described ongoing eco-friendly projects, including the ultraviolet disinfection system, anaerobic digesters, micro turbine systems and a recently completed oxidation ditch while guiding students on a tour of the plant. Students viewed the wastewater treatment plant as a model for green infrastructure throughout Long Island and the country.
