ADA construction complete



The Great Neck Water Pollution Control District (GNWPCD) recently held a ribbon cutting ceremony to recognize the completion of construction projects at the district enabling the district's administration building at 236 East Shore Road to be Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant.

In order to complete the project, the district was awarded a grant of \$50,000 from the Nas-

sau County Community Revitalization Program and \$50,000 from the state.

"The District is grateful for Legislator Ellen Birnbaum's dedication to securing these grants on behalf of all District residents," District Chairperson Jerry Landsberg said. "Her contribution has ensured the district is able to accommodate the physical needs of all residents."

In order to be compliant

with ADA standards the district renovated the entryway and offices to be handicap accessible.
